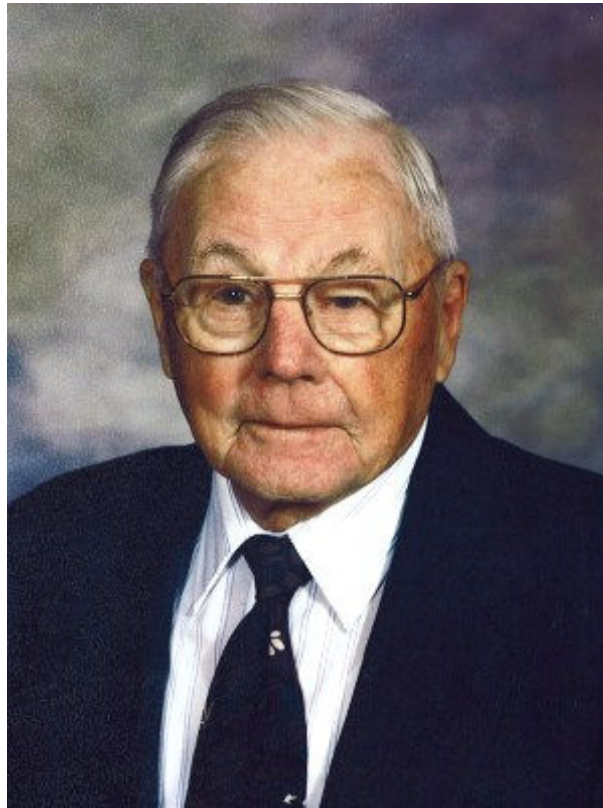

Carl M. Swanson, 98, died Wednesday, July 18, 2007 in Eventide Lutheran Home, Moorhead MN. Funeral services for Carl were held on Sunday, July 22, 2007, at Concordia Lutheran Church.

Carl was born January 3, 1909 in Clay County, MN to Ole and Thea (Svenkeson) Swanson. He lived and worked in Clay County and served in the military during WWII, stationed in Victorville, CA. After serving he returned to Moorhead and worked for
