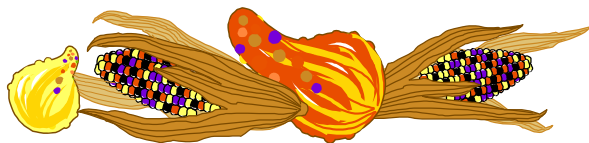

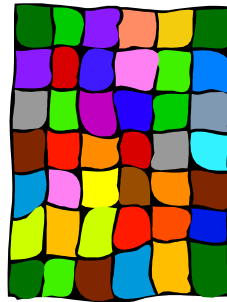

Flyer regarding tests to prevent a stroke

There was a pink flyer advertising this screening in a recent newspaper for \$139.00 which included 4 tests to help prevent stroke. At our recent Faith Community meeting with MeritCare they advised that if you had a physician that you saw regularly this test was really a waste of money. If they did find something they would refer you to your regular doctor who would probably redo the test on their own equipment. Sometimes in all the moving and traveling of equipment it may not be accurate. However, if you do not see a doctor on a regular basis then these tests may alert you to a problem. There is additional information posted on the church bulletin board on MeritCare's position on this.








